Cancellation, Delay and Early Dismissal Notice (2018)

Glasgow Independent Schools values safety for all Scottie students. During inclement weather administrators are assessing road and travel conditions as well as weather forecasts. Decisions to cancel, delay or dismiss school requires much thought and planning. It is our intent to communicate a decision as early as possible in order to allow our families to make arrangements for child care.

The district administrators will report school closings to **local television (WBKO-TV Channel 13, WTVF-TV Channel 5 and WDRB-TV Channel 41) and radio (WCLU (1490/102.3 and WHHT 103.7 and WOVO 106.3) stations.** We will also communicate closings through the **One Call Now Messenger System.** Please ensure that your child's school has the most current contact information so you receive important messages.



## **School Cancellation**

A decision to cancel schools will be made by approximately 6:00 a.m. Decisions to proceed with afternoon or evening events is determined by the school principal, in consultation with the superintendent, and is based on conditions and forecasts with safety in mind.



## **School Delay**

A decision to delay school will cause bus pick up times to be adjusted by either one (1) or two (2) full hours. The school day will end at the normal time with afternoon bus routes running on regular schedule (pending road conditions).



## **School Early Dismissal**

A decision to dismiss school early will be based on current and forecasted weather. Afternoon and evening events will be considered. Parents of children enrolled in afternoon programs will be asked to pick up their children. Staff will remain with students until a parent or authorized adult arrives.

Decisions about making up instructional time missed will be made in accordance with current state guidelines. School calendars may be adjusted.

*We ask that parents check the contact sources included in this communication concerning inclement weather school delays and closings. Calls to the schools or district office may delay our ability to notify staff and the public of important decisions.*
